Remembering Flag Day June 14

Flag Day is an appropriate time to recall the story of one of the most reproduced photographs; the famous flagraising at the battle for Iwo Jima in World War II.

Joe Rosenthal, an Associated Press photographer, captured the scene on Feb 23, 1945, after being told that a patrol was headed up a nearby hill with an American flag. He and other photographers had to navigate through mine fields and run for cover six times as U.S. Marines bombed Japanese forces hiding in caves.

By noon, they had reached the summit in time to see six men straining to erect a 20-foot iron pipe bearing a huge American flag. Rosenthal made a pile of sandbags and rocks to get an elevated view and took the photograph for which he received a Pulitzer Prize.

Three of the men in the photograph were killed before the battle was over. Nearly 7,000 other soldiers died in action on Iwo Jima out of more than 20,000 American casualties

"In a way, it is a picture of a miracle," Rosenthal said. "No man who survived that beach can tell you how he did it. It was like walking through rain and not getting wet."

Do you remember the famous escape artist, Harry Houdini? Houdini had often boasted that he could escape easily from any jail cell in the country. Frequently, he would demonstrate his ability to do just that, but once something went very wrong.

Houdini had been placed in a prison cell that had a large padlock on the door. When the heavy door clanged shut, Houdini pulled out a piece of thin metal that had been concealed in his belt and started to pick the lock. For thirty minutes, he worked on the lock, but couldn't get it open. An hour passed, he was bathed in sweat, but still couldn't pick the lock.

Two hours went by and he finally collapsed in frustration against the door he could not open. But when he fell against the door, it swung open. It had never been locked! In his mind it was locked, and that's all it took to keep him "locked" in and frustrated.
